The Importance of Slinger / Signaller Training

Many employers are under the impression that a lorry loader course also provides candidates with the knowledge and skill required for slinging and signalling, but this is not the case as additional training and assessment needs to be undertaken in order to be proficient in this area.

The use of inadequately trained slingers / signallers is a major cause of accidents. Even if such accidents do not cause a fatality or an injury, they will almost certainly lead to costly legal action or damaged equipment. Therefore, quality slinger / signaller training is a must. A properly trained slinger / signaller is also a more profitable one, providing higher levels of efficiency and less down time, as well as a safe working environment. ALLMI instructors can supply the rigorous and all-inclusive training necessary to achieve these benefits.

Course Content

The ALLMI slinger / signaller course content is extremely comprehensive and so cardholders are able to use their skills when performing slinging and signalling duties with any type of lifting equipment, not just lorry loaders.

The strength and quality of ALLMI slinger / signaller training courses comes from the technical and training knowledge on the Association's Training Standards Committee. The Committee is made up of training and technical professionals from the UK's leading lorry loader crane manufacturers, importers, fleet owners and training companies, as well as the HSE. Every successful candidate receives a certificate and identity card, as well as the ALLMI Slinger / Signaller Manual. ALLMI certification is valid for five years, after which time refresher training and assessment will need to be undertaken.

Quality of Instructors

The ALLMI instructors are fully trained and qualified in the techniques of slinging and signalling, and are audited annually in order to ensure that a high standard is maintained across the ALLMI training provider network.

Driver CPC

It may be possible for slinger / signaller training to count towards an individual's Driver CPC hours, as the ALLMI course is registered (JAUPT). However, your ALLMI training provider must also become an approved centre for Driver CPC and register the training with JAUPT in advance of the course.
